For this purpose many seminars and short term training programmes are organised at frequent intervals drawing experts from relevant fields. Campus Interviews are also organised by inviting many companies to the college. These companies recruit promising graduates to work for their concerns. A placement officer is appointed exclusively for this purpose.

Achievements of Placements Cell. Our College placement cell has been working effectively since 2004. So far it has helped 2114 students to get their placement in reputed companies.
