Library

A well equipped library with adequate seating arrangements and standard reference books, is open to the students from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. It subscribes standard journals, periodicals and newspaper. A qualified librarian is in charge of this library with about 55,859 books. A separate English language Laboratory is available to impart effective communicative skill. A talking Book Library is also available for the visually handicapped students. A regular collection of international research journals are available on different disciplines.

Bus

The TNSTC plies a lot of city buses from Periyar Bus Stand to our College. Mofussil buses from Mattuthavani, Central Bus Stand bound for Natham and beyond also touch our college campus. There are also many Mini Buses plying from Mattuthavani Bus Stand, K.Pudur Bus Stand, and Goripalayam.

Students Counseling Center

In order to provide a congenial academic environment and thus ensure a cohesive personality development of the students, a counselling centre for the students is functioning in the campus.

Intensive Training in Communication Skills and Personality Development

As the courses are designed to mould managers of professionals, who would effectively suit the global requirements, effective communication and resourcefulness, management become the essential components of the courses. Keeping this scenario in mind, an Intensive training in communication skills and personality development by inviting experts in the relevant fields have been made an additional feature of the curricula of the courses. We have an immense optimism that this arrangement will go a long way in building necessary confidence and resourcefulness among the prospective professional to effectively encounter the growing challenges in the field of the modern times.

NCC

NCC provides training to students with view to develop officer-like qualities in them. The College has NCC Wing for boys and girls. The college has ONE company of NCC Infantry Wing (boys & girls). The cadets are given training in drill, map reading, shooting, field craft, first aid and fire fighting and also sent to attend various adventure camp like Republic Day Parade (RDC) at New Delhi, Himalayan mountaineering, rock climbing, paragliding, trekking and various leadership and advance leadership camps at different places. Outstanding cadets are entitled to selection for going abroad under youth exchange programme (YEP).

Training and Placement

In order to motivate the students Career Counselling Centre has been established to develop a focus regarding their future plan. They are exposed to various career options and many relevant higher education programmes with greater potential of job opportunities. For this purpose many seminars and short term training programmes are organised at frequent intervals drawing experts from relevant fields. Campus Interviews are also organised by inviting many companies to the college. These companies recruit promising graduates to work for their concerns. A placement officer is appointed exclusively for this purpose.

Achievements of Placements Cell. Our College placement cell has been working effectively since 2004. So far it has helped 2114 students to get their placement in reputed companies. During the last two years around 704 of our final year students have been placed. In the academic year 2016-2017, itself 172 of our students received their placement order. The cell also organises enrichment programmes for our final year students by inviting experts from various industries.

In addition to their regular programmes of study, the students are encouraged to take up one or two relevant Certificate / Diploma courses which are offered after the college working hours. This will equip and enable the students to face the reality with great confidence after their graduation.
